RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY OUTDOOR DINING AND RIGHT OF WAY CLOSURES PURSUANT TO GOVERNOR'S EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 150 AND OTHER STATE GUIDANCE

WHEREAS, the Governor's Executive No. Order 150 issued June 3, 2020 permits municipalities to exercise authority to allow "food or beverage establishments" to expand their footprint to outdoor areas, both privately and municipally owned, with operation in accordance with state guidelines; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Town of Secaucus want to support the reopening plan locally and allow food or beverage establishments to have outdoor dining areas on both privately and municipally owned land with safe operation in accordance with federal, state and local regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council of the Town of Secaucus, County of Hudson, State of New Jersey, authorize the issuance of "Temporary Outdoor Dining Special Event Permits" for local food or beverage establishments within the Town of Secaucus' zoning boundaries for operation beginning June 15, 2020, in accordance with the Governor's COVID-19 reopening plan and Executive Order No. 150; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any temporary outdoor dining for local food or beverage establishments permitted within the Town of Secaucus' zoning boundaries shall be maintained, and operated in accordance with the State of New Jersey Governor's Executive Order No. 150, the State of New Jersey Department of Health Executive Directive No. 20-014 COVID-19 Protocols for Food or Beverage Establishments Offering Service in Outdoor Areas Pursuant to Executive Order No. 150, the State of New Jersey Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control SR 2020-10 Special Ruling Establishing Temporary COVID-19 Permit to Expand Licensed Premises and the Town of Secaucus Temporary Outdoor Dining Special Event 2020 Additional Rules and Regulations, and local health regulations as amended and updated during the Event period; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the application entitled "Temporary Outdoor Dining Special Event Permit Application 2020" is hereby approved and shall be submitted by local food or beverage establishments to and reviewed by the Town Zoning Officer, Town Engineer, Police Chief, Fire Official, Fire Department, Department of Health or their designees; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that no fee will be required by the Town of Secaucus for a 2020 Temporary Outdoor Dining Permit; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secaucus Police Department and the Town Engineer are authorized to continue to assess and designate areas in the public right of ways on Golden Avenue (near Front Street), the Plaza Center Municipal Parking Lots and the North End Municipal Parking Lot as sites for temporary outdoor dining. To achieve such designation, the Council authorizes the closure of roads and the suspension of parking meters in the designated

areas as approved by this Council or the Town Administrator and set forth on a drawing on file with the Town Zoning Official; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if the Secaucus Police Department and the Town Engineer assess and recommend designation of other areas in the public right of ways in the vicinity of local food or beverage establishments as sites for temporary outdoor dining to further promote the spirit and intent of this resolution, the Council authorizes the closure of roads and the suspension of parking meters in said designated areas upon approval of the Town Administrator with a drawing to be kept on file with the Town Zoning Official; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any limitation on outdoor dining established by Town Ordinance, Chapter 135 shall be temporarily suspended until September 7, 2020, or until this Resolution is revoked, whichever is earlier; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any Town Ordinance in conflict with the purpose and intent of this Resolution or the regulations referenced shall be temporarily superseded until September 7, 2020, or until this Resolution is revoked, whichever is earlier; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all other applicable federal, state and local regulations remain in effect and be enforced; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor, Town Administrator, or their designee are hereby authorized to take any action necessary to effectuate the spirit and purpose of this resolution.
